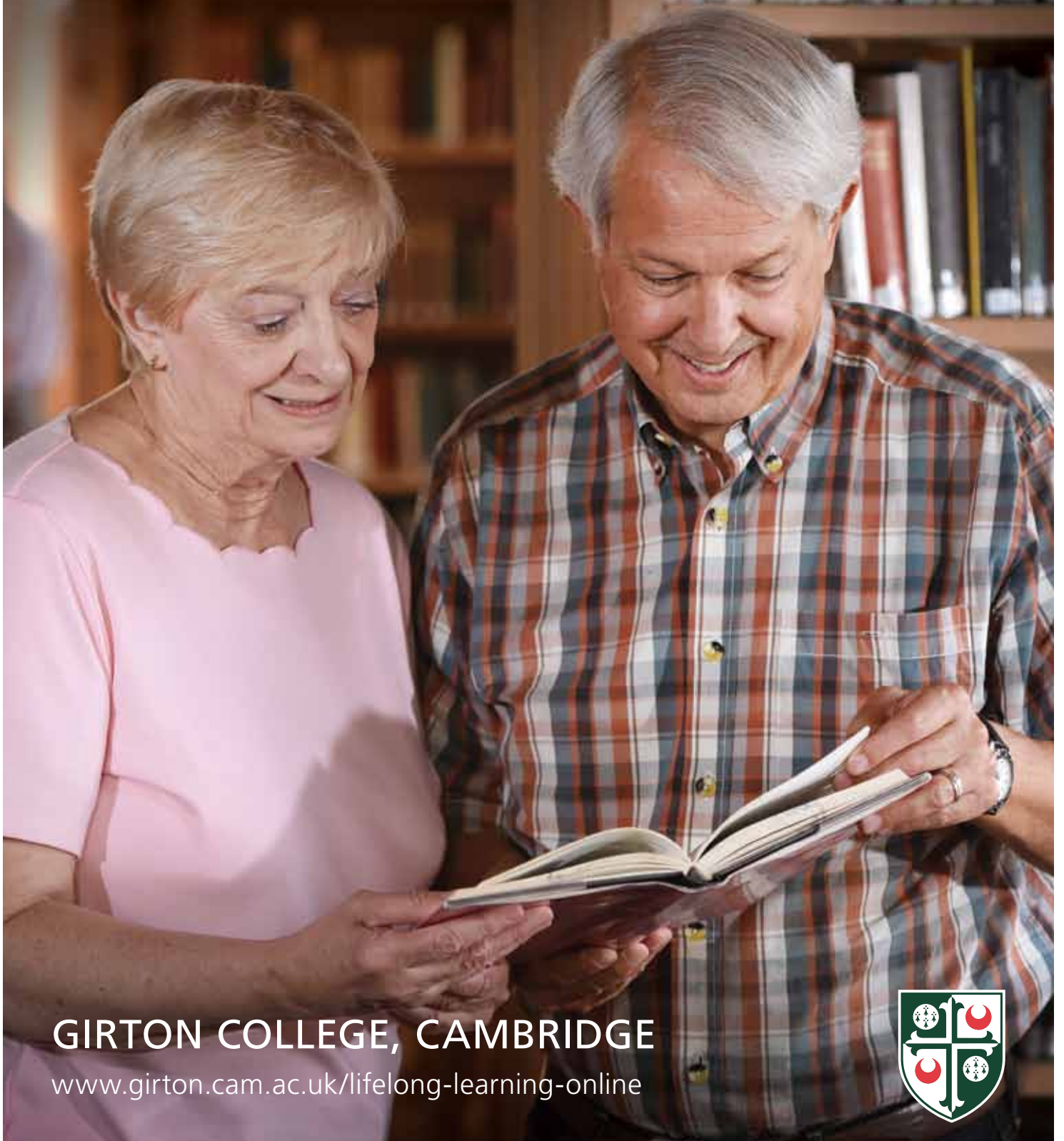

The *Online* Girton College Lifelong Learning Summer School

11 – 22 JANUARY 2021



Founded in 1869 Girton College is one of the constituent colleges of the University of Cambridge. The College's beautiful buildings and spacious grounds are located just outside the city centre, and Girton is well known for its relaxed and friendly atmosphere. This online summer school gives lifelong learners from around the world the exceptional opportunity to experience something of Cambridge student life in the context of an online programme specifically designed for adult learners.

Academic course

Participants will take a course entitled *The Lives of Winston Churchill: from Victorian Britain to End of Empire, 1876–1965*, which explores Churchill's fascinating life in the context of an important period in British history. The course will comprise seven and a half hours of live online teaching. Course material is accessible to all, and only an interest in the subject is required. There are no exams; participants study for the joy of learning.

College life

Although the summer school will be online this year, we will help participants appreciate Cambridge and its history through a couple of special talks or visits. There will also be an online social event to encourage participants to get to know one another.
